Dear Parents,

I would lie to give a **BIG THANK YOU** to the parents who showered me with flowers, plants, gift cards, coffee cups, fabric paints, and heartwarming notes of appreciation!! You are all very much appreciated.

Kindergarten is right around the corner and Ms. Natalie, Ms. Jessica, and I strive to give your child the best Pre-K experience! Please help us by going over your child's work and bringing them to school on time! Any art or other subjects missed are projects that can't be redone. That means cutting, gluing, writing numbers, letters, learning a song, socializing cannot be recapped.

Throughout the year, I have incorporated storybooks into parties. In May, the children learned to recite Humpty Dumpty. The children made an art project by building a "wall" from red rectangle paper, cut out an oval shape, drew a face on it, and called it Humpty Dumpty. For the food project the children brought in a hard boiled egg and drew a face on it to resemble Humpty Dumpty and watched a waffle being made (the wall). My last book and food project will be "Where the Wild Things

Are." I will be incorporating colors from the story for the food. On the menu is turkey meatballs, mashed potatoes, sweet potatoes, peas, corn, animal crackers, and bugles. I know most children refuse to eat certain foods at home, but at school they are always eager to try new food!

The Pre-K classes will be starting to learn their graduation songs and poems on June 1st. Rehearsals will start **EVERYDAY** at 9:00 a.m. Please have your child here on time. This is the only time all three classes will be getting together to rehearse. Graduation is on June 29th at 7:00 p.m. in the church. Please have your child here by 6:45 p.m. on that day. June 29th is also staff development day. We will be Closed but will reopen on July 2nd and closed again on July 4th. I have tons of projects planned for the summer and I hope to see you all!!

Friendly Reminders:

Please remember to check your child's extra clothes to make sure they still fit.

During the summer your child will have water play days. On July 2nd, please bring a swimsuit, towel, and sunblock in a backpack. Your child's wet towel and clothes will go home to be washed on the day that they are used. Please return them

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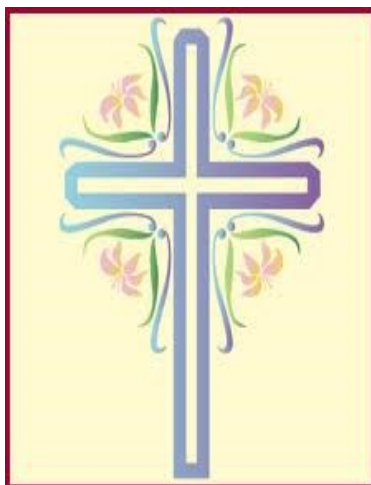

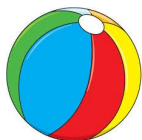
